<p>This couple just bought a beautiful new house, but knew they would have to do a little work to get it to feel like home. They were empty nesters who couldn't wait for their families to come visit for home cooked meals. But the existing kitchen, while large, felt separated. The sink was quite far from the main work area, and the kitchen felt separated from the adjacent living space.</p> <p>Problems/wants:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Sink felt outside of kitchen -Kitchen felt separate from living space -Old aluminum windows were inefficient -Thermofoil white cabinetry too stark/cheap -Parquet floor looked dated -They didn't want to see the appliances -Microwave was too high -Wanted a warm, traditional style with lots of room for display and countertop space -Needed better ventilation and cook surface away from seating and grandchildren's fingers -Do a lot of cooking, so would like a second oven <p>Solutions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Opened up wall and resupported upper level to get rid of structural post. This served to open up the space to allow one large area great for entertaining -A new narrow arched window provides a beautiful focal point and gives more wall space for cabinetry -Used Wellborn Madison Maple Mocha Crème cabinetry for warm, old world feel with contrasting island -Custom wood clad hood over 36" range allowed for a great cooksurface and ventilation -Custom panels on their refrigerator and dishwasher integrated their appliances and made them part of the furniture -Lit Cabinetry with mullions grids, glass doors and shelves provide ample display and storage and provide attractive focal points -Customized interiors of cabinetry include: waste basket/recycle units with servodrive motor for hands free use, corner pull outs, pullout shelves, spice drawers 				

-A large, functional island that included a second oven, built in microwave, prep sink for better work triangle, large work surface great for prep and baking. It also provides seating on the family room side

-Decorative base around cabinetry gives a furniture look to all cabinetry

-White subway tile with accent below the hood gives a clean, bright look that still provides texture and interest

-White Genesis honed granite gives a beautiful, durable surface that ties the cabinetry and floor together

-Hand scraped mahogany floors throughout give a deep warmth that compliments the cabinetry

-New recessed lighting and undercabinet lighting brighten up the entire area

The finished kitchen is a wonderful, open kitchen with a warm traditional feel and elegant touches – perfect for this family.
