<p>Design Statement</p> <p>Historic Craftsman</p> <p>This kitchen remodel project was for a Craftsman style home built in the early 1900s.</p> <p>The homeowner and his fiancée wanted a kitchen to entertain a few friends for wine or coffee. The couple needed space for a single cook to prepare light meals with storage for limited cooking utensils and dishware. A coffee station and limited wine storage were to be the focal points of the space.</p> <p>The kitchen cabinetry is Wellborn Premier Lancaster Square Maple in “Espresso”. The run of cabinetry along the range wall incorporates a single base spice pull-out and a 3-drawer base cabinet at the left of the range. At the right is a standard base cabinet for pot and pan storage with wall cabinets at each side of the microwave for dishes and glassware. At the recessed wall space that runs perpendicular to the range wall is a wall open shelf cabinet used as a base wine cubby. Above is a wall cabinet with wine glass holders attached beneath.</p> <p>Opposite the range wall is a reduced-height wall with the sink and dishwasher. To the right of the dishwasher is a trash pull-out. To the left of the sink is a standard 15”W base cabinet. Perpendicular to the 15”W base cabinet is a modified wine rack cabinet for a base wine rack. The back of the reduced-height wall provides seating for three. This wall is decorated in the Craftsman style using universal fillers. Woven corbels add embellishment and provide countertop support.</p> <p>The coffee station was designed as a stand-alone feature. The base cabinet is 30”W with a sliding shelf and a drawer. A 15”W wall cabinet houses cups and mugs and is flanked by 6”W wall filler pull-outs in which coffee, creamers and sweeteners are stored. The wall cabinets were designed in staggered heights to add visual interest.</p> <p>With no built-in pantry in the space, a wall of three 21”W pantries was designed opposite the coffee station. These pantries offer not only storage but also aesthetic appeal as you view the kitchen through the arched opening from the living room.</p>
